CIRCULAR

The 8th Millennium National Scholarship Examination will be held on **Saturday 31st October - 2008** from **10.00 a.m. to 12.00**. The schedule and other details of the exam are given below.

Eligibility

Students from LKG, UKG and classes I - X of English medium schools of any State or Union territory in India and overseas schools following the syllabus prescribed by any Board in India are eligible to appear for this exam. There will be separate exam for each standard.

Awards and Scholarship

The first ten rank holders in each class in the exam at the national level will be presented with Gold, Silver and Bronze medals. They will be eligible to receive cash awards of Rs. 1000/-, Rs. 750/-, Rs. 500/-, Rs. 450/-, Rs. 400/-, Rs. 350/-, Rs. 300/-, Rs. 250/-, Rs. 200/-, Rs. 150/-, (LKG, UKG) Rs. 2500/-, Rs. 1000/-, Rs. 500/-, Rs. 450/-, Rs. 400/-, Rs. 350/-, Rs. 300/-, Rs. 250/-, Rs. 200/-, Rs. 150/- (I – X) respectively. Consolation prizes for 150 students at the national level from each class at the rate of Rs. 100/- will be awarded. **There will be a special cash award of Rs. 200/- for the class top, one for each class from each school. Schools having less than 10 participants from one class will not receive a class top prize. First Ten rank holders will not receive an additional cash prize award for being the class toppers.** All the candidates who score 'A' grade will receive merit certificates. All the participants in the exam will receive a participation certificate from the Millennium Examination Council and their grade will be mentioned in the certificates. **The schools which produce excellent result and maximum participation will be honoured with special mementos and trophy.**

Mode of Exam

Mode of exam will be objective. **LKG Students will have a question paper containing 30 questions with multiple choice and colouring with crayons for 10 marks. And UKG students will have a question paper containing 35 questions with multiple choice and colouring with crayons for 15 marks. Duration of the exam will be 2 hrs. Classes I – IV will have a question paper containing 50 questions with multiple choice. Questions must be answered in the OMR sheet. Duration of exam will be of two hours. Classes V – VII will have to answer a question paper of 60 questions within two hours on OMR sheet. Classes VIII to X will have to answer 100 questions with in 2 hrs. on OMR sheet.**

Exam Centres and Honorarium for Invigilators

All the participating schools having minimum 100 participants will be exam centres and such schools are requested to give permission to MEC to use their schools, as exam centres. The principals are kindly requested to make available the service of their teachers as invigilators for LKG, UKG and classes I – X in their respective schools. **These invigilators May be paid Rs. 150/- each as Honorarium from the amount deducted by the School.**

Syllabus

The syllabus for the exam comprises **Maths & Science** (based on the school syllabus), **General knowledge and Mental Ability** thoroughly graded to suit the candidates of each standard. Copies of the syllabus and model question papers will be sent to the participating schools by 30th August 2009 after receiving the entry forms.

Result and presentation of Awards

- The result of the exam will be published on 31st December 2009 and the list of the first ten rank holders will be published in our Website **www.macspala.com**
- Cash awards, medals, trophies, mementos, merit certificates and participation certificates will be sent to the respective schools by the 28th of February 2010
- Rank list and the photographs of the first 10 rank holders of the MEC 2008 exam are given in our website **www.macspala.com**

How to Participate

- In form No. 1 number of participating candidates in the exam from each class is to be filled in the appropriate columns.
- Enter the names of the participating students along with their respective classes in a CD/ Floppy Disc if possible. Please make the entry in MS Excel and send us the CD/Floppy Disc along with form No. 1 and the Demand Draft.
- Kindly follow the sample format given below.

Fees

A nominal amount of Rs. 80/- for LKG, UKG and classes I – X has to be collected from each candidate towards the exam fees. The schools having exam centers may retain Rs. 10/- per candidate in advance from the amount collected to meet the expenses of conducting the exam, postage, invigilation etc at your centres. The balance amount of Rs. 70/- per candidate should be sent by **Demand Draft in favour of MEC (Millennium Examination Council) payable at Pala/Kottayam branch of State Bank of India / Canara Bank (Arunapuram, Pala) / Central Bank / State Bank of Travancore / Federal Bank or any nationalised bank.** Overseas schools participating in the exam will have to bear the additional expenses, which may be incurred in conducting the exam there.
